CHILD-ON-CHILD HARMFUL SEXUAL BEHAVIOR

In four years, allegations of children committing sexual offenses against other children have risen 78% in the UK.

More common in Missouri than experts had previously believed...2000 cases in five months vs the estimated 600 cases each year.

CHILD-ON-CHILD Sexual Abuse

A 2009 study estimated 50% of child sexual abuse is perpetrated by other children or young people.

Other studies found closer to one third.

Adolescents account for 15-20% of arrests for all sex crimes annually.



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


A Public Health Threat

Revolution in Accessibility



- 2016: People watched 4.5 billion hours of porn on one pornography tube site.
- 2018: **33.5 billion visits**

92 million visits daily average
4.79 million new video uploads/1 million hours of new content/115 years of pornography if continually watched.



- Australian study of 941 15-29 year olds
- Median age for first viewing pornography was 13 years for males and 16 years for females.
- 100% of males and 82% of females reported they had ever viewed pornography.
- Among those who had viewed pornography within the last 12 months, 84% of males and 19% of females used pornography on a weekly or daily basis.
- Australian reports from the early to mid-2000s showed that the rates of lifetime exposure to pornography had been 73-93% for adolescent boys and 11- 62% for adolescent girls.



THE HETERO PORNOGRAPHY SCRIPT

A content analysis of 172 videos from a popular pornography site examined the influence of age (teenage performer vs. adult performer) on aggression and pleasure depicted in popular heterosexual pornographic videos uploaded to the site between the years 2000 and 2016.


- 90% of teenage females in videos containing
 visible aggression displayed pleasure, compare
 to 54% when visible aggression was not present.
- Teenagers were significantly more likely to display pleasure in videos that included spanking, forced vaginal or anal penetration, and forced gagging than in videos that did not include these acts.
- Females of all ages were more likely to display pleasure in videos featuring physical aggression than those that did not.

CONTINUED: The Pornography Script

The researchers noticed that these trends "may signal to viewers of all ages that these acts are not only normative and legitimate, but perhaps even expected," thus creating social pressure on both young women and men to re-enact them with their sexual partners.

PORN & THE BRAIN

Since 2011, results of **41** Neurological studies assessing the brain structure and functioning of Internet porn users and sex/porn addicts is consistent with **320+** internet addiction "brain studies" supporting the premise that Internet porn use can cause addiction-related brain changes, as do studies reporting escalation or tolerance. These brain studies reveal porn has negative and detrimental impacts on the brain.



STUDIES FIND ESCALATION AND HABITUATION IN PORN USERS (TOLERANCE)

Compulsive porn users often describe escalation in their porn use that takes the form of greater time viewing or seeking out new genres of porn. New genres that induce shock, surprise, violation of expectations or even anxiety can function to increase sexual arousal, and in porn users whose response to stimuli is growing blunted due to overuse, this phenomenon is common.

Meta-analysis, 22 studies, 7 countries

Consumption of pornography was associated significantly with both verbal and physical aggression, among males and females.

Likelihood to Rape

Mainstream Pornography:

* greater intent to commit rape

SM Pornography:

- * significantly less bystander efficacy
- * greater belief in rape myths
- * greater intent to commit rape

- * greater belief in rape myths
- * greater intent to rape

Increased Female Sexual Victimization

Italy: A study of 14- to 19-year-olds found that females who watched pornographic videos were at significantly greater likelihood of being victims of sexual harassment or sexual assault.19

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Physical and Sexual Victimization

U.S.: A nationally representative survey of pornography use among youth aged 9-17, found that those with increased exposure to Internet pornography were significantly more likely to report physical and sexual victimization.

THE INTERSECTION BETWEEN PORNOGRAPHY AND CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE

Adults use adult pornography to groom children to

- EDUCATE children in mechanics of sexual behavior
- ENCOURAGE children to re-enact these behaviors
- EXCITE children sexually
- ENTER children into sexual contact with adults and/or other children

FUELING CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE MATERIAL

A 2013 survey of a general population of Internet pornography users revealed that those who intentionally sought pornography at a younger age were significantly more likely to be users of **pornography exhibiting the sexual abuse of animals and children**.

CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE MATERIAL Collectors' tastes grow More severe over time

Study analyzed the evolution over time of the activity of consumers of CSAM, using data extracted from the hard drives of 40 convicted individuals. A sample of t hese images (N = 61,244) was categorized by the age of the subjects depicted and using the Combating Paedophile Information Networks in Europe (COPINE) scale by severity of acts depicted.



• 37.5% of the collections exhibited increased severity in terms of both age and COPINE [extremeness] score: The children depicted became younger, and the acts became more extreme

• [A second pattern was] exemplified by ... an increase in the COPINE [extremeness] score and in the age of the subjects.... This pattern was present in [an additional] 20%.

• It should be noted that all the CSAM collections included mainstream pornography content.

CONTINUED: Child Sexual Abuse Material Collectors' tastes grow More Severe over time



- Explanation related to the sexual interest explanation is that collectors become habituated to low-severity pornography, which is
 congruent with the patterns 1, 2, and 3 of the current study. It has been suggested that habituation to pornographic content leads to
 boredom, which in turn impels the pornography consumer to seek out new content that is more severe.... Thus, to maintain their
 degree of sexual arousal, CSAM collectors may be driven to explore other age categories and sexual acts.
- CSAM collectors have the possibility of exploring a wider range of sexual interests than offline sexual offenders, who are limited by
 the availability of victims. This explanation is in agreement with Babchishin et al.'s (2015) meta-analysis, which reveals that online
 offenders have more deviant sexual interests than offline offenders.

PORNOGRAPHY Exposure Abuse

"Children exposed to pornography during the period of time when they should be channeling their energy toward non-sexual development, are at higher risk of developing dysfunctional sexual health attitudes and behaviors.

Overexposure to images, stories, and more sophisticated sexual experiences may be disruptive to children (6–12), who may not have the sexual resiliency to handle intrusive exposure to sexually explicit material.

IMPACT ON CHILDREN & TEENS

- Early exposure among children effects
 - psychological, physical, & social development
- Fosters sexual "mis-education"
- Teaches hardcore pornography is normal and desirable
- Desensitizes the viewer and increases appetite for more deviant, bizarre, or violent types of pornography
- Facilitates sexual aggression and early sexual debut and risky sexual behaviors
- Damages emotional bond with caregiver
- More at risk for physical and sexual victimization



IMPACT ON CHILDREN & TEENS

- Negative body image
- Pressure to perform pornographic acts
- Increased child-on-child sexual abuse
- Voyeurism
- More likely to engage in or demand sexting
- Cyberharassment and bullying
- Outing & trickery
- More lax attitudes about rape & sexual assault
- Associated with adolescent delinquency and criminal behavior







PORN IS CHANGING SEX

"Young men want to imitate ideas presented in porn, and young women feel pressured and anxious about a need to conform. Findings support evidence that young people may be internalizing the violent and aggressive images and sexual scripts in porn, which are in turn influencing their sexual behavior and creating new sexual norms that are based on power."



TEEN DATING VIOLENCE & PORN

Research shows that adolescent dating abuse is associated with more frequent pornography use, viewing pornography in the company of others, and being asked to perform a sexual act that a partner first saw in pornography.

Approximately 50% of adolescent dating abuse victims reported that they had been asked to do a sexual act that their partner saw in pornography.


VIOLENT PORNOGRAPHY VIEWING CORRELATED WITH Youth Acting out

A 2011 longitudinal study of 1,588 U.S. households found that minors who intentionally viewed violent pornography over time predicted a sixfold increase in the odds of selfreported sexually abusive behavior for both boys and girls.


59 Study Meta-Analysis of Age 12-18 Male Sexual Offenders:



Adolescents who had sexually offended were significantly more likely to have had early exposure to pornography, report higher rates of exposure to pornography, have significantly more atypical sexual fantasies, behaviors or interests (sex with animals, incest, pedophilia, etc.), and were more often diagnosed with a paraphilia than non-sex offenders.

The researchers suggested that promising directions for further research include the roles of exposure to sexual violence, exposure to sex or pornography more generally, and atypical sexual interests.


Pornography, Sexual Coercion and Abuse, and Sexting



4,564 young people aged 14 to 17 in five European countries; included 91 personal interviews.

- Boys' perpetration of sexual coercion and abuse was significantly associated with regular viewing of online pornography.
- Viewing online pornography was associated with a significantly increased probability of having sent sexual images/messages for boys in nearly all countries.
- Boys who regularly watched online pornography were significantly more likely to hold negative gender attitudes.
- Sexting has the potential to reproduce sexist features of pornography such as control and humiliation

Sibling Sexual Abuse - Latzman Study

In a study that analyzed 166 cases of males aged 13-17 who were referred to a residential sex offender program in the Midwestern United States from 1994-2005

Compared to those in the non-sibling group, sibling abusers had higher rates of previous sexual abuse (58% to 35%), physical abuse (49.5% to 44.6%), neglect (33% to 21%), domestic violence exposure (58% to 20%) and had higher rates of pornography exposure (58% to 24%).

The study concluded that "Exposure to domestic violence and a sexualized home environment (in this case, exposure to pornography and/or child sexual abuse) may render adolescents particularly at risk for sexual violence."

Sibling Sexual Abuse - Latzman Study Cont.

Researchers also suggested that "exposure to pornography may negatively impact the sibling-victim in addition to the sibling-offender," and "early exposure to pornography may impact a child's view of what is normative and impair the ability to avoid, deter, or negotiate from dangerous situations..."




IMAGE-BASED SEXUAL ABUSE (IBSA)

"Non-consensual creation and/or distribution of private, sexual images"

Types of IBSA:

- Revenge pornography"
- Upskirting
- Pornographic

photoshopping/"Deepfake" pornography (i.e. identity theft)

- Sextortion
- Recording sexual assaults/rape
- Other nonsexual photos with sexually demeaning/threatening messages



One 15-year-old girl wrote:

"I sent my boyfriend a naked pic after he insisted he was going to break up with me. Now he is threatening to send it to everyone if I don't have sex with him, I'm only 15."


SEXTING, COERCION, VIOLENCE

Coercion

- 61% of teens who sent a sext indicated coercion
- Women are more likely to be coerced into sending sexts
- Coercive sexting is linked to intimate partner violence


Violence

- Sexting is a significant predictor for dating violence
- Those sexting under pressure report higher rates of victimization in dating violence

48% GERMAN STUDENTS AGED 14-17 EXPERIENCED AT LEAST ONE FORM OF NON-PHYSICAL SEXUALIZED VIOLENCE

Three times as many girls than boys reported being sexually harassed or propositioned online.

Examples included being forced to look at someone else's genitals, or that someone spread rumors with sexual content about the respondent, or that someone made sexual jokes, insults or comments to the respondent.



SEXTING & TRAFFICKING

Sexting is frequently an "online extension of offline forms of sexual coercion."

NCOSE

Los Angels County Sheriff Department's Human Trafficking Bureau gave comprehensive update on number of human trafficking cases involving children and young teens taking nude photos of themselves and sending over the Internet. They investigated 519 HT cases involving nude photos of young girls and boys; 1:4 appeared to be "selfies" produced by the children.



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

"THE TALK" IS OBSOLETE

Parents reacted to their children watching pornography in one of five ways:

- Anger,
- Punitive measures, or directing shame at the child;
- Panicky or fearful;
- Ignored, minimized, or denied what had happened, or lied to their child about what the child had viewed.
- Calm and factual;

MAKE A PLAN

Stay Calm!

Teach children what pornography is in age-appropriate ways.

Help your child to understand that sex is normal and that porn doesn't represent true intimacy.

Practice with your family what to do if they see pornography.

Use examples in the media and news.

Never use shame or guilt as teaching tools. Help your child to know that they should never feel guilty for being curious but that he or she can COME TO YOU with questions.

Follow up frequently.

Federal law prohibits distribution of obscene adult pornography on the Internet, on cable/satellite TV, on hotel/motel TV, in retail shops, through the mail, and by common carrier. The U.S. Supreme Court has also repeatedly upheld obscenity laws against First Amendment challenges.






